April has finally arrived... complete with spring snow, a winter chill on many mornings, and 80° temperatures on the horizon! It's no wonder that poet T.S. Eliot referred to April as "the cruelest month."

As Catholics, we are still in the Easter season, celebrating the Resurrection and new life for the next seven weeks, through Ascension Thursday, up to Pentecost. In school, our eighth graders are making final preparations for Confirmation on April 17, and second grade is counting the days until First Communion on May 5. Other signs of spring are popping up throughout the school as well... seedlings growing in the 4th grade classroom, butterfly habitats in pre-school and Kindergarten, beautiful artwork hanging in the halls.

Some of the events planned for April and May include a Junior High dance on April 13, Pre-K Adventure Day for prospective students, a free toddler music/art program entitled "MARCH into Spring," kids' canvas night, our annual Science Fair, the Spring Concert, Dance for Education and Fun & Fitness Day. Consult the school calendar or website for details on all of these programs and spread the word to family and friends. We always welcome new faces!

There are a few items of a very general nature which need to be addressed. Our school day begins at 7:40 AM. Students may be dropped off beginning at 7:20, no sooner. Students should be dropped off at the Maple Avenue door if they are able to exit the car quickly by themselves. For younger students, or students who may need assistance, parents should park in the lot closest to the church and walk their students to the courtyard entrance near the kitchen.

Another item which needs attention is the school dress code. Please take time to assess the condition of uniforms, lower the hems on pants/skirts, replace missing buttons, etc. Our complete uniform code is found in the school handbook beginning on page 33. For families needing uniforms, PTA will be holding a swap on April 25. Don't forget, summer uniforms may be worn starting on May 1.


