



## Fifth Grade Supply List

- 2 red ballpoint pens for correcting work (**no** felt tips, rollers, or gel ink)
- 1 **zippered** pencil case (no pencil boxes)
- 2 Highlighters
- 1 dry erase marker (low odor)
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 **clear plastic** protractor
- 12 inch/30 cm wooden ruler
- #2 pencils (not mechanical pencils); a **generous supply** (Please replenish as needed.)
- 2 packages of loose-leaf filler paper (**wide ruled**: not college ruled)
- 5 marble copy books (**wide ruled**: not college ruled)
- 2 good erasers (Please do not send in the type which are small figures/toys.)
- blue ball point pens (**no** felt tips, rollers, or gel ink); no light colored or neon ink
- colored pencils (12 pack); crayons
- scissors (child size)
- Clear Contact paper (All copybooks & workbooks must be covered in clear contact paper. **Please cover the books at home during the first week of school.**)
- 5 **jumbo-size** book sox or other book covers (Textbooks must be covered at all times. Students may cover their **text books** with book sox **in class** in September.)
- 4 boxes of tissues (more may be needed later in the school year)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 container of antibacterial wipes
- 2 packages: white lined 3x5 index cards
- 1- 3x5 index card case

**Art Supplies:** Elmer's glue; colored pencils; eraser; scissors; black Sharpie marker; regular pencil; markers; crayons (at least 64 crayons); Crayola (16 watercolor set)

**Reminder:** Art supplies for Art class must be carried to class. A **plastic shoe box** of supplies may be stored in the classroom. Boxes must not be larger in size due to limited storage space.

Please do not bring binders/trapper keepers. There is no room to store these.
